

## Insulation, Air Sealing & Furnace Rebate Funding Availability

The Governor's Energy Office (GEO) Rebate Program has funds available for insulation, air sealing and furnaces at this time, but **availability depends on where the applicant lives**. The following cities and counties currently have funding available to their residents for the noted category.

- If you live in an area of the state that is **NOT** listed above you may still apply for a rebate but your community is at wait list status. The wait list means funds are not guaranteed. You still have the option of securing a reservation, completing the work on your home, and submitting the rebate verification paperwork listed in the instructions on your confirmation page. **IF** funds become available due to expired reservations, and your paperwork has been received and approved, you may receive a check from the GEO. The GEO encourages residents to complete the energy efficiency upgrade if one's intention is to have the work completed regardless of the rebate. If the rebate is the impetus for having the work completed, and your community is at waitlist status, the GEO recommends holding off as funds cannot be guaranteed.
- The Insulation & Air Sealing Rebate is calculated based on the local government or utility incentives available to a customer. Due to Federal requirements, the GEO makes its calculations based on what local incentives existed in September 2009. If your local government or utility has changed their incentive since that time, your Recharge Colorado Rebate may vary slightly from what is listed on the Recharge Colorado website.
- Rebates are available while funds last. Terms and conditions apply.
