

Recharge Colorado Residential Rebates

The Governor's Energy Office is offering the following residential rebates until funds are exhausted.

Energy Efficient Appliances	Product Criteria	Rebate Amount
Clothes Washers	Modified Energy Factor greater or equal to 1.8, water factor less than or equal to 7.5	\$75
Dishwashers	Less than or equal to 324 KWh per year, less than or equal to 5.8 gallons per cycle	\$50
Refrigerators	Must be larger than 12 cubic feet in volume	\$50 w/out recycling \$100 w/ proof of recycling
High Performance Gas Storage Water Heaters <i>(Includes propane and natural gas)</i>	Energy Factor greater than or equal to .67	\$200
Gas Boilers	Minimum AFUE greater than or equal to 85%	\$400

Renewable Energy	Rebate Amount
Residential Solar Domestic Hot Water	\$2000 - \$3000 <i>Amount may be less if local incentives are available</i>
Residential Photovoltaic <i>Xcel and Black Hills customers do not qualify.</i>	Up to \$1.50/watt for the first 3kW. <i>The per-watt payment may be less if local incentives are available.</i>
Residential Wind	<i>Rebate amount depends on local partnership status.</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> \$2.00/watt up to 5kW with a max of \$10,000 when outside partner territory \$3.00/watt up to 5kW with a max of \$10,000 when inside partner territory <i>Currently, partners include Colorado Springs Utilities, Mountain View Electric Association, San Miguel Power Association and Southeast Power Association.</i>
